#### Documentation needed to register:

- Must be 19 years and older and have a government-issued picture ID with birth date. May be US or Foreign (i.e. driver's license, state ID, passport, visa, military ID, matricula consular, etc.)
- 18 years old: Must bring school withdrawal or High School completion information and government-issued ID.
- 17 years old: Must bring school withdrawal paper, parent permission, and government-issued ID.
- 16 years old: Must bring COURT ORDER along with a government-issued ID.
