## **TWO DIMENSIONAL WORKS**

Two dimensional works in any surface is accepted. Matting/ Framing is not necessary. If framed, it must have a hanging hardware on the back. Drawings in charcoal or other dry media must be spray fixed and free of smudge. Wet media must be completely dry.

## **THREE DIMENSIONAL WORKS**

Three dimensional works of any media will be considered. Accepted works must be stable enough for safe handling. Any works that consist of multiple parts must be security taped or attached together.

**Please consult the art gallery if you wish to enter other media such as digital works.**



## **LIABILITY**
