



Application and Registration Procedures

- 1. New students must file an application to become a COM student at http://www.com.edu/apply. Students may file for financial aid at http://www.com.edu/yeterans. Fire Academy scholarships are available from the COM Foundation at http://www.com.edu/yeterans. Note: Applications for financial aid and scholarships must be filed by specific due dates, which are listed on the applicable web sites. Prospective cadets are advised to complete these applications as early as possible.
- 2. Prospective Fire Academy cadets must complete a Fire Academy application and obtain a medical physical. The forms may be downloaded from the links at the bottom of Fire Academy web site at http://www.com.edu/academics/fire-technology/academy.
- 3. Complete the application, attach the required documents listed on the cover page, and get a medical physical from your doctor or a clinic. Turn the application and physical into the Administrative Assistants at the Public Service Careers (PSC) building at 1205 Amburn Rd., Texas City, TX 77591. Note: In order to enroll in the fall semester academies, the forms should be tuned in no later than the end of July and for the spring semester, prior to the Christmas break in December.
- 4. Orientation, interviews, and registration will be conducted at the PSC building the week prior to the beginning of the Academy. **Orientation dates will be listed in the Announcements section of the Fire Technology web site at** http://www.com.edu/academics/fire-technology/academy.
- 5. After orientation, students accepted into the Academy will receive a registration form that allows them to register at Admissions on the main campus. Tuition and fees must be paid at the time of registration, although payment plans may be arranged. If a student has obtained financial aid or a scholarship, verification will be required. After registration, provide a copy of the payment receipt to the Administrative Assistants at the PSC building.
