Testing Information for High School Students

College of the Mainland offers all potential Dual Credit, Collegiate High School students, and College Connection Seniors a one-time, free test to be used at their high school or at the College of the Mainland Testing Center. Students will receive their free TSI voucher upon completion of the required steps listed below.*

Steps to receive a free TSI test voucher

<u>Step 1:</u> Go to <u>www.applytexas.org</u> and fill out the 2-year college application to College of the Mainland which generates a required COM student ID in 3-5 business days.

<u>Step 2</u>: Go to <u>www.com.edu/tsiapp/</u> to complete the state-mandated TSI Pre-Assessment, and print out/screen shot the certificate at the end.

<u>Step 3</u>: Take your TSI Pre-Assessment certificate with your COM ID number (seven-digit number) to sign up for the testing date at your school with your high school counselor or a College Connections Advisor.

<u>Step 4</u>: Your voucher will be ready for you on test day at your school.



*Retest Policy: If you fail to meet the college readiness level after two attempts, you must wait 14 days before retesting on that section.
