2. Get registration card from Testing Center to pay \$25 fee before you test.

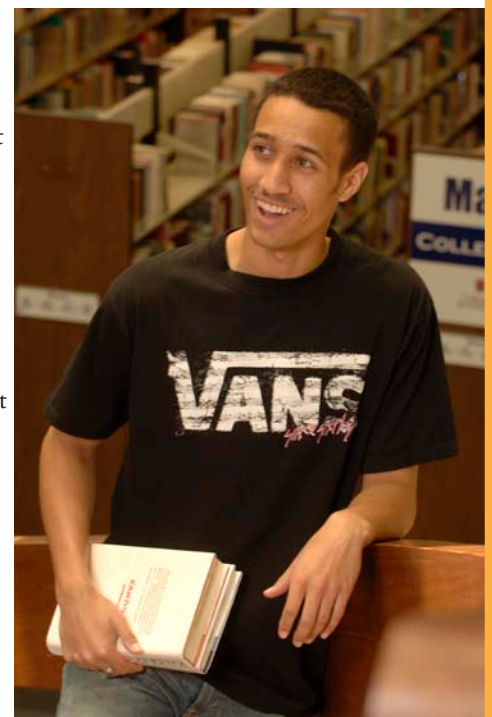
TEST DAY:
