Before making a recommendation to the Board regarding a contract with a food service provider for the College District, the administration shall consider the report and recommendations of the Student Committee on Food Service Providers (the "Committee"), in accordance with the following procedures.

At least 90 days prior to the expiration of a contract for a food services provider, the Vice President for Fiscal Affairs (VPFA) shall convene the Committee in accordance with the following procedures.

The Committee is composed of the following five members:

1. Three student members who are enrolled for not less than six semester credit hours at the institution and who are representative of all students enrolled at the institution, selected by the student government.
2. Two student members who are representative of the institution, appointed by the President.

A student member of the Committee who withdraws from the institution must resign from the Committee.

A vacancy in a Committee position shall be filled for the unexpired portion of the term in the same manner as the original appointment.

The Committee shall:

1. Consider input from students regarding the College District's food service provider.
2. Prepare and submit to the VPFA a written report regarding their recommendations regarding the College District's food service provider.

The Committee shall meet on a monthly basis beginning on the date on which the Committee is convened, and ending on the date on which the College District executes a contract with a food service provider.

The Committee shall conduct meetings at which a quorum is present in a manner that is open to the public. Notice of such meetings, including the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting, shall be posted at least 72 hours before the meeting is convened in the following manner:

1. On the College District website; and

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2. In the student newspaper, if an issue of the newspaper is published between the time of the internet posting and the time of the meeting (if applicable).

The final recommendations made by the Committee must be recorded and made public.
