DEFINITION OF
COLLEGE DISTRICT
OFFICIALS

For the purposes of this policy, College District officials are the Title IX coordinators and the College President.

TITLE IX
COORDINATORS

Reports of discrimination based on sex, including sexual harassment or gender-based harassment, may be directed to the Title IX coordinators. The College District designates the following persons to coordinate its efforts to comply with Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, as amended:

The College President or designee shall serve as coordinator for purposes of College District compliance with all other antidiscrimination laws.

A student shall not be required to report prohibited conduct to the person alleged to have committed the conduct. Reports concerning prohibited conduct, including reports against the Title IX coordinators, may be directed to the College President.
