INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION

Students must apply through their home high school campus for recommendation to attend CHS.

- 1. Meet with your high school counselor to discuss whether you are prepared for this Academically Advanced Program and to learn your school's process for submitting applications.
- 2. Obtain an *Application Packet* from your high school counselor or download it from the Collegiate High School web page (www.com.edu/chs).
- 3. Complete College of the Mainland's Application at www.com.edu OR www.applytexas.org. If this is not completed a minimum of seven (7) days before registration, a student will not be able to enroll at COM or Collegiate High School. THIS IS A SEPARATE APPLICATION!
- 4. Testina
 - a. Prepare for the TSI if you do not have SAT or ACT scores. www.collegeboard.org/texas-sample-questions.

ALL STUDENTS MUST TAKE A <u>PRE-ASSESSMENT TEST</u> TO BE ELIGIBLE TO TAKE THE TSI EXAM and must print the pre-assessment test certificate and give it to the Testing Center.

b. **Take the TSI Exam (college placement exam)** at COM's Enrollment Center. The fee for this test is \$29. **A PICTURE ID IS REQUIRED FOR TESTING.**

- SAT scores*: EBRW score of 480 or higher. A mathematics score of 530 or higher is required to enroll in college level math.
- ACT scores*: English score of 19 or higher. A mathematics score of 19 or higher is required to enroll in college level math.
- PSAT: EBRW 460, Math 510
- (STAAR EOC) minimum score of 4000 on Level II of English II, TSI waved for Reading and Writing.
- (STAAR EOC) minimum score of 4000 on Level II the Algebra I STAAR EOC and passing grade in the Algebra II course; or End of Course (STAAR EOC) minimum score of 4000 on Level II Algebra II; TSI waved for Math.

- 5. Complete the **Student Application Form.** Be sure to print legibly and fill in all requested information. Do not leave any spaces blank. Sign the application.
- 6. Have your parent complete the *Parent Recommendation Form*.
- 7. Ask three of your current teachers and your assistant principal to complete their *Recommendation Form*.

^{*}Math scores required for college level math; not required for CHS acceptance.

^{*}These scores must be provided to the Admissions Office directly from the testing company or must be identified on the official high school transcript.

- 8. Write a *Personal Essay*, 200-300 words, explaining why you believe that you are a good candidate for your school 's Collegiate High School program and should be selected. Career goals and personal aspirations should be an integral part of this essay. We recommend that you complete a career interest survey and research related careers to be sure that this career pathway is right for you.
- 9. Follow your school's procedures for submitting the completed application packet: *Application Form*, personal essay, a copy of your latest State Assessment Score Report, transcript (official transcript upon acceptance), the TSI scores (or exemption scores) and Parent Recommendation Form.
- 10. Copy of your official Immunization Record indicating Meningitis Vaccination.
- 11. Watch for an email from CHS when your application is received. (This is a different letter than the one you will receive concerning your enrollment status at COM.)

Target Dates:

We will begin accepting applications in March 2018 or sooner for Summer I, Summer II and the Fall 2018 semesters.

Applications will be reviewed as we receive them from our partnering school districts:

Last day to enroll and register for Summer I classes is June 7, 2019 Last day to enroll and register for Summer II classes is July 12, 2019 Last day to enroll and register for Fall 2019 is August 16, 2019 Last day to enroll and register for Spring 2020 is January 10, 2020
