

Cohort Achievement Measures


The Cohort Achievement Measures is a simplified way to think about and measure student success. Fall cohorts of entering students, both first-time in college and new transfers attending full-time or part-time, are tracked. If at the end of their third year, they have **completed a degree or certificate**, are **still enrolled and in good standing** (have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0), or are **no longer enrolled but were in good standing when they left**, they are included in the success rate.

College of the Mainland's most recent success rate for the 2015 cohort is **72%**.

COM's success target is 70%.

Cohort Success Rates






