



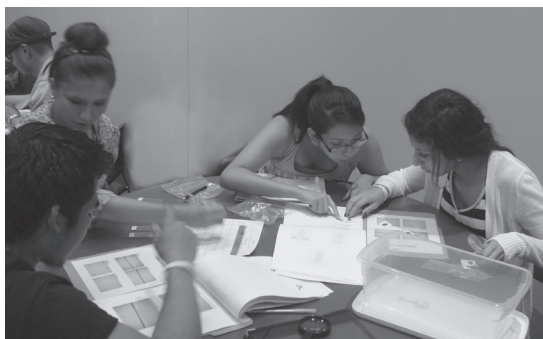

Who is Eligible?

- Currently attending:
 - Dickinson School District

- Must demonstrate academic potential
- Must be a U.S. Citizen or U.S. legal resident
- Must meet income guidelines
- Must be a first-generation college student
